Ideally we would like to accommodate all who might choose to worship, but COVID makes this impossible. As a result, we have decided to pre-record a service of lessons and carols filmed in our beautifully decorated sanctuary, featuring all of our talented musical groups. We encourage you to gather your family in some virtual fashion to enjoy the service together on Christmas eve.  - ◆ bi-weekly check of all exit doors to make sure they are locked and locks/key pads are working properly
 - ◆ after a light snowfall, if contract snow removal company is not already at church, shovel sidewalks before E2 classes begin
 - ◆ maintain COVID sanitation supplies
 - ◆ provide assistance in changing church decorations
 - ◆ call contractors as required for serious maintenance issues such as electrical, furnace, key lock, etc.
