Dear Friends,

Can you recall the last time someone saw you? Saw you? Can you remember how it touched you to be seen? In this week's Gospel story, Jesus meets a Samaritan woman, and sees her. He sees her without the cultural conditioning of prejudice that taught that he, a Jew, shouldn't converse or connect with a woman of Samaria. He is present to her. She is so deeply affected by this encounter that she runs back into town and tells everyone about him, how he knew her, what he is. She overflows with gratitude.

Offering presence is part of our call as people of faith. We are called to be present to the gifts of this moment, present to our family, our friends, our neighbours, to the stranger in the street and the person sitting next to us in the pews. When we are present, we see through sacred eyes, and we see the holy in the mundane. Then *gratitude* overflows through our lives. We'll explore this on Sunday in our second week of the series "Better Together."

Also, if you have a quilt to loan, we are using them in worship through the month of October. If you, like me, forgot it last week, feel free to bring it any Sunday and thank you!
