Dear friends:

For this second Sunday in Lent, we'll be exploring the [story of Nicodemus](#). He comes to Jesus "by night," a symbol in John's gospel that someone is a bit confused, or that something profound is about to happen.

It seems to me many of us come to Jesus "by night," perhaps a bit confused, but ready for something profound. Many are the questions of faith that swirl in us. And yet, we keep taking one step after another, growing in faith daily.

This week, our focus question is *"How do we begin again?"* What does it mean to start fresh, carried by grace?

We'll also share in Holy Communion. If you're joining us in person (recommended!), please pick up your name tag on your way in, it helps our Communion servers immensely. If you're joining us online, you can have a piece of bread and a cup of something nearby if you'd like to share in the sacrament.
