Today we mark Good Friday—a day that invites us to slow down and join Jesus at the cross. The story we will enter is not easy. It moves through fear, injustice, and loss. It shows us a love that does not bend, even under immense pressure, strain and pain.

We gather at 10:30 for this solemn service. We will hear the account from John's gospel, sing, and witness the symbols of Christ's life fall away. Today, we don't rush to the rest of the story. We stay with him at the cross.
